The Institute of Economic Growth (IEG), an autonomous research and training Institution

established in 1952, conducts research in several areas of Economics, Sociology, and

Demography. IEG desires to fill up one post of Chair Professor (General category)

through <u>a Search-cum-Selection Committee</u>, in the newly established TATA Chair on

Information Technology at the Institute for a period of 4 years. Funding for the Chair is

likely to be extended. The position carries a monthly pay as per Academic Pay Matrix

Level-14 (Pay Band Rs.1,44,200 - Rs.2,18,200) with allowances admissible from time to

time at the IEG.

The Tata Chair will conduct research, provide training, and coordinate activities under

the Chair.

The candidate should have an outstanding academic record with a Ph.D. and, should

process the following qualifications:

Essential Qualifications

Eligibility (A or B)

A. (i) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in Economics or Finance and

published work of high quality, actively engaged in research and policy with

evidence of published work, with a minimum of 10 very good research publications

in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of 120 as

per the criteria given in Appendix-II, Table 2 (enclosed).

(ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as

Assistant Professor/Associate Professor and/or research experience at an

equivalent level at University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates.

Or

B. An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in Economics or Finance from any academic institution (not included in A above)/industry, who has significant publications and has made contributions to the field of Economics/Finance supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.

Desirable Qualifications

- a. Demonstrable experience in successfully collaborating and/or leading research and or evidence-based policy analysis as part of a research project or programme.
- b. National and International experience in partnering with Government Institutions and/or Multilateral Institutions.
- c. Candidates' work should be in the areas of Information and Communication Technology, Information Economics, Industrial Organization, Productivity, Government Policy and regulation, Service Sector Growth, and other related fields.

The Search-cum-Selection Committee will adopt its procedure for selection and make a recommendation to the Chairman and Board of Governors. Selection is <u>not</u> confined to those who have applied or have been nominated. A nomination for the post shall also be considered by the Committee. Applications should be accompanied by a comprehensive bio-data as well as a brief note outlining a justification as to why the candidate is suitable for the post.

Nomination/Application should be sent in a closed cover with a CV, 5 Best Publications, and three names of referees to the **Director**, **Institute of Economic Growth**, **University of Delhi Enclave**, **North Campus**, **Delhi 110007**, marked on the cover "Application/Nomination for the Post of Chair Professor in the Tata Chair on Information Technology" or by email to sibasankar@iegindia.org with a copy to the diroffice@iegindia.org, on or before 19th February 2024 and hard copy of the applications along with all essential documents at IEG latest by 29th February 2024.

General Instructions for Candidates

- 1. The application has to be filled out online on the Institute's website i.e. www.iegindia.org under the "Career" web link along with the instant advertisement. The application is to be submitted online by 19th February 2024 followed by a hard copy along with all essential documents at IEG by 29th February 2024.
- 2. After submission of the online application, applicants are required to download the filled-up application form and send it along with self-attested educational qualification certificates and testimonials (hard copy). Also required to send the names of three references and copies of the ten best publications by post.
 - On the top of the envelope, write "Application for the Post of Professor, TATA Chair on Information Technology addressed to the Director, Institute of Economic Growth, University of Delhi Enclave, North Campus, Delhi–110007. The hard copy of the application should arrive by **29**th **February 2024.**
- 3. Candidates working in Government/Autonomous Bodies/Universities/ Institutions of repute must send the hard copy of the application through the proper channel. The salary of the candidate working in the pay scale will be protected if selected.
- 4. Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) or Overseas Citizens of India (OCI), if selected, the appointment will be on contract for up to three years subject to clearance from the Govt. of India before he/she can join the Institute. Extension beyond three years will be subject to a review process and necessary approvals.
- 5. Applications, that do not meet the criteria given in this advertisement and/or incomplete applications, are liable to be summarily rejected.
- 6. Consequent to the adoption of self-certification provisions as required by the Government of India, the Institute shall process the applications entirely based on information/ documents submitted by the candidates duly self-attested. In case the information/documents are found to be false/incorrect by way of omission or commission, the responsibility and liability shall be the sole responsibility of the candidate.
- Candidates called for physical interview should report along with all the testimonials/certificates in original along with photo ID as per eligibility conditions.
- 8. Candidates should possess the prescribed qualification and experience as of the closing date of application.
- Further, merely fulfilling the minimum qualifications or the eligibility criteria does not entitle a candidate to be necessarily considered or called for an interview.
 More stringent criteria may be applied for short-listing the candidates to be called for an interview.

- 10. No correspondence or personal inquiries shall be entertained by the Institute. Correspondence, if any, in this matter will be sent to the e-mail ID of the candidate.
