The Research score for research papers would be augmented as follows:

Peer-reviewed or UGC-listed Journals (Impact factor to be determined as per Thomson Reuter's list):

- i) Paper in refereed journals without impact factor - 5 Points
- ii) Paper with an impact factor of less than 1 - 10 Points
- iii) Paper with impact factor between 1 and 2 - 15 Points
- iv) Paper with impact factor between 2 and 5 - 20 Points
- v) Paper with impact factor between 5 and 10 - 25 Points
- vi) Paper with impact factor >10 - 30 Points
- (a) Two authors: 70% of the total value of publication for each author.
- (b) More than two authors: 70% of the total value of publication for the First/Principal/Corresponding author and 30% of the total value of publication for each of the joint authors.

Joint Projects: The Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each.

Note:

- Paper presented if part of an edited book or proceeding then it can be claimed only once.
- For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for Supervisor and Co-supervisor. The supervisor and Co-supervisor, both shall get 7 marks each.
- *to calculate the research score of the teacher, the combined research score from the categories of 5(b). Policy Document and 6. Invited lectures/Resource Persons/Paper presentations shall have an upper capping of thirty percent of the total research score of the teacher concerned.
- The research score shall be from a minimum of three categories out of six categories.

The API Score claim of each of the sub-categories in the Categories from 1 to 6 (Research, Publications, and Academic Contributions) will have the following cap to calculate the total API score claim for the post of Professor:
