- (iv) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal.
- (v) Field work experience in India.

The hard copy of the application should reach by September 10, 2024.
- 3. Candidates working in Government/Autonomous Bodies/Universities/ Institutions of repute must send the hard copy of the application through the proper channel. The salary of the candidate working in the pay scale will be protected, if selected.
- 4. Applications, which do not meet the criteria given in this advertisement and/or incomplete applications, are liable to be summarily rejected.
- 5.
