Professor Sabyasachi Kar has been appointed as the Director of the Institute of Economic

Growth (IEG), New Delhi, on the 6th of February 2025. He succeeds Professor Chetan Ghate.

Sabyasachi Kar is the RBI Chair Professor at IEG and a member of the committee on

Regional Accounts of the Ministry of Statistics and Program Implementation (MOSPI).

Previously, he was the co-editor of the Journal of South Asian Development and an Honorary

Senior Research Fellow at the University of Manchester.

Professor Kar holds a Ph.D. in economics from the Jawaharlal Nehru University. His research

interests span macroeconomics, economic growth, development economics, and political

economy. His scholarly contributions include numerous articles published in national and

international academic journals and in edited volumes. Among his notable books are

'Macroeconomic Reforms, Growth and Stability' 'Economic Challenges for the

Contemporary World, and 'The Political Economy of India's Growth Episodes'.

Over the years, Professor Kar has worked closely with government organizations like the

Indian Planning Commission, and later on the NITI Aayog, contributing macroeconomic

projections and other inputs to the formulation of economic policy for the Indian economy.

He has also collaborated academically with international organizations like the World

Bank, the Global Development Network (GDN), the European Commission, and the UK's

DFID.
