(Relaxable for candidates with the higher qualification) (The posts may be from different disciplines).</p> <p><b>Desirable:</b> Preference will be given to candidates from aforementioned and allied subjects with relevant experience in collection/analysis of data/conducting of field surveys and having work experience in the areas of Reproductive and Child Health and issues relating to NHM and other national health programmes. Experience in Monitoring and Evaluation activities is strongly preferred. Research experience in handling mixed qualitative and quantitative data is desirable.
