Rolling Advertisement for the post of Chair Professor in RBI Unit

IEG is seeking to appoint a Chair Professor (at Level 14 as per 7th Central Pay Commission Rules) in the RBI Endowment Unit of the Institute. The appointment will be for a period of 2 years tenure only. The RBI Unit has been set up to promote research and higher levels of learning in Macroeconomics, Economic Growth, and Macro Development. In addition to conducting research at the highest level in any of the Unit's focus areas, the appointee will contribute to the Institute's broader activities, including training, teaching, and sponsored research. As a senior faculty member, leadership roles may be assigned to you.

Essential Qualifications for a Professor's Position on 2 years tenure basis.

Eligibility (A or B):

(A).

(i) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per the criteria given in Appendix-II, Table-2.

(ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in a university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and/or research experience at an equivalent level at the University/National Level institutions, with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidates.

OR

(B). An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant/applied disciplines, from any academic institution (not included in A above)/industry, who has made a

significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence, provided he/she has ten years' experience.

Applicants applying on a *tenure basis* for the post of **Professor** must submit their applications through the proper channel. The application should be duly forwarded by the parent department/organization.

A certificate from the employer to the effect that the particulars furnished by the candidate have been verified and found correct, and that in the event of selection, the applicant will be relieved to join the post.

Applications not received through the proper channel or without the above-mentioned documents are liable to be rejected.

The terms and conditions of tenure, including pay, allowances, tenure, and other service matters, shall be governed by the relevant **Government of India/IEG rules and instructions on tenure, as amended from time to time.**

Merely fulfilling the criteria will not be considered as a candidate's right to selection. Only short-listed candidates will be called for an interview. The Institute reserves the right not to fill the above position if circumstances so warrant. The Institute can also consider suitable candidates who may not have applied. The decision of the Selection Committee shall be final.

- In the event of candidates not being found suitable, the post may not be filled.
