Rolling Advertisement for the Post of Professor (On Short-Term Contract Basis)

The Institute of Economic Growth (IEG), an autonomous research and training Institution established in 1952, conducts research in several areas of Economics, Sociology, Demography, and conducts training for the Indian Economic Service Probationers. The IEG is inviting online applications from eligible and distinguished academicians/researchers for engagement as Professor at Academic Pay Matrix Level-14 (Rs.1,44,200-Rs.2,18,200) (on Short-Term Contract Basis) in the Indian Economic Service (IES) Unit of the Institute against a leave vacancy. The appointment against this vacancy will initially be for a period of one year and may be extended for a further period of one year, subject to requirement and satisfactory performance.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION FOR A PROFESSOR'S POSITION ON A SHORT-TERM CONTRACT BASIS

Eligibility (A or B):

A.

(i) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in Economics, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per criteria given in Appendix-II, Table 2 (enclosed).

(ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in a university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and /or research experience at an equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidates.

Or

B. An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in Economics from any academic institutions (not included in A above)/industry, who has made a significant contribution to the knowledge in the Economics, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.

Work Requirement

Will need to teach applied macroeconomics in the training programmes for the Indian Economic Service held at the Institute. Being able to teach one or more of microeconomics, applied econometrics, and public economics is useful. The applicant should have extensive teaching experience at the post-graduate level.

Applicants applying on a short-term contract basis for the post of Professor must submit their applications through the proper channel. The application should be duly forwarded by the parent department/organization.

A certificate from the employer to the effect that the particulars furnished by the candidate have been verified and found correct and that, in the event of selection, the applicant will be relieved to join the post.

Applications not received through the proper channel or without the above-mentioned documents are liable to be rejected.

The terms and conditions of tenure, including pay, allowances, tenure, and other service matters, shall be governed by the relevant Government of India/IEG rules and instructions as amended from time to time.

Merely fulfilling the criteria will not confer any right to selection. Only shortlisted candidates will be called for an interview. The Institute reserves the right not to fill the position if circumstances so warrant. **The Institute can also consider suitable candidates who may not have applied. The decision of the Selection Committee shall be final.**

Candidates are required to fill out the online application form available on the Institute's website (www.iegindia.org) under the Career section.

Applicants are also required to download and print the filled-up form and send it along with self-attested educational qualification certificates and testimonials with names of three referees by post to the Administrative Officer, Institute of Economic Growth, University of Delhi Enclave, North Campus, Delhi – 110007. The cut-off period for submission of applications in the first phase is from **8 July 2026 to 23 July 2026**.

In the event that the position remains unfilled after the first phase, the advertisement shall continue as a **rolling advertisement**, and applications will be accepted until the position is filled.
