The Institute of Economic Growth (IEG), an autonomous research and training institution established in 1952, invites applications from eligible and suitably qualified candidates for **five (5) positions of Research Analyst (2 positions) / Senior Research Analyst (2 positions) / Consultant (1 position)** on a contractual basis for the following research project:

Project: “A Study on Assessing the Need for Specialist Services and to Develop a Roadmap with the Aim to Capture Requirement of Specialist Doctors in the Country”

Funding Agency: National Medical Commission (NMC)

Position, Remuneration and Tenure

Number of Positions: 5

The selected candidates will be selected through a **Walk-in Interview** and engaged on a contractual basis with a consolidated remuneration in the range of **Rs. 60,000/- to Rs. 80,000/- per month**, depending upon the position, qualifications and relevant experience.

Tenure: 5 months, which may be extended by another 1 month, subject to the requirements of the project and satisfactory performance.

Minimum Educational Qualification

Candidates should possess at least a **Second-Class Master's degree** in any one of the following disciplines: **Demography / Population Studies / Statistics / Economics / Mathematics / Sociology / Psychology / Anthropology / Public Health/ Master of Computer Application.**

Work Experience and Essential Skills

Candidates possessing the following experience and skills will be preferred:

- Experience in health research and analysis of large-scale survey data.
- Sound knowledge of quantitative techniques and data analysis.
- Proficiency in statistical software such as STATA/SPSS.
- Working knowledge of computer applications and MS Office Package.
- Experience in the collection, compilation, processing and analysis of primary and secondary data.
- Ability to work independently as well as part of a research team.

Roles and Responsibilities

1. Collection of primary and secondary data relevant to the project.
2. Conducting and assisting in fieldwork in different parts of India.
3. Compilation, cleaning, processing and management of research data.
4. Analysis of large-scale survey and health-related data using appropriate quantitative techniques.

5. Use of statistical software, including Stata/SPSS, for data analysis.
6. Preparation of tables, analytical reports, presentations and research outputs.
7. Coordination with field teams, institutions and other stakeholders, as required.
8. Any other research-related responsibility assigned under the project.

Note: Fieldwork in different parts of India is an essential component of the project, and selected candidates may be required to travel extensively as per project requirements.
