INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS:-

1. The interested bidders are advised to go through the tender document carefully and satisfy themselves against the eligibility criteria laid down therein.
2. Two bid system shall be followed for this tender. The bidders shall submit his tender/bids as per the following procedure:
 - i. **"Technical Detail"** must be furnished in **Annexure-A** along with tender document and all the required documents (duly signed and stamped all the pages) in a separate sealed envelope superscribing **"Technical Bid"** with the name & address of bidder/firm/agency.
 - ii. **"Financial Bid"** must be furnished in **Annexure-B** in a separate sealed envelope superscribing **"Financial Bid"** with the name & address of bidder/firm/agency.
 - iii. The Demand Drafts/Pay orders for **Tender Fee and EMD** must be submitted in a separate envelope superscribed as **"Tender Fee & EMD"** with the name & address of bidder/firm/agency.

All the three envelopes as cited above, i.e., (i) Envelope for Technical Bid, (ii) Financial Bid and (iii) Tender Fee & EMD must be submitted in a sealed main envelope superscribed as "Civil and Electrical Conduit Work for Audio Video Room of IEG". 3. The details provided in Annexure-A & B, along with all enclosures, certificates etc. and corrections in the tender, if any, should be signed and stamped by the bidder before submission.
4. All the details should be provided in ink. Overwriting/applying correction fluid should be avoided.
5. The quotation shall remain valid for a period of 120 days from the date of opening the bid.
6. The acceptance of the tender in part or whole shall rest with the Competent Authority of the Institute, who reserves to himself/herself the authority to reject any or all the tenders received without assigning any reason thereof.
7. Bids, which do not fulfill any of the conditions, mentioned here in above or herein below or are incomplete in any respect, will be rejected.
8. Bidders must have successfully completed or substantially completed similar works during last seven years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited should be either of the following:
 - 8.1 Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost; or
 - 8.2 Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost; or

- 8.3 One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.

“Similar Work” means “Civil and Electrical Conduit work in auditorium/Audio Video Room/conference room etc.

9. Bidders must have valid PAN card and GST registration certificate.

10. The participating agencies shall submit the following self-attested copies along with their bids duly signed and stamped on each page:

SCOPE OF WORK

1. Dismantling Works

Dismantling of the existing floor tiles, wooden partitions, wooden doors, windows, frames (chowkhats), shutters and other identified items, including careful removal of serviceable materials, disposal of unserviceable materials outside the Institute premises, and complete site clearance.

2. Disposal of Malwa/Debris

Collection, loading, transportation and disposal of all dismantled malwa/debris generated during the execution of the work to an approved dumping location outside the Institute premises, including all labour, equipment and transportation.

3. Acoustic Partition Wall

Providing and fixing acoustic partition walls of 75–100 mm thickness comprising GI/metal framework with high-density mineral wool/rock wool/glass wool insulation (minimum 48–60 kg/m³ density), covered on both sides with double layers of 12.5 mm thick acoustic gypsum boards. The work shall include framing, insulation, jointing, finishing, corner protection, sealants, cutting for openings and all necessary accessories complete as per manufacturer's specifications. Approved makes shall include **Gyproc (Saint-Gobain), Knauf India or Ramco.**

4. Masonry Opening Works

Making openings in existing brick masonry walls/floors by cutting masonry for installation of doors, including dismantling, making good damaged surfaces, matching existing finishes and disposal of debris complete.

5. Fixing of Wooden Chowkhats

Providing and fixing wooden door frames (chowkhats) in existing openings including embedding holdfasts in cement concrete, application of approved wood preservative, making good damaged masonry and flooring, and completing all related works.

6. Cement Plaster

Providing and applying 12 mm thick cement plaster in cement mortar mix 1:4 (1 Cement : 4 Coarse Sand) on repaired wall surfaces, finished smooth and ready to receive putty and paint.

7. Plain Cement Concrete (PCC)

Providing and laying M-15 grade Plain Cement Concrete (PCC) of average thickness 75–90 mm using 1:2:4 mix for achieving the required floor level, including surface preparation, compaction, finishing, curing and all incidental works.

8. Vitrified Tile Flooring

Providing and laying approved make vitrified floor tiles (Kajaria/Somany/H & R Johnson or equivalent) of size 600 × 600 mm including skirting, polymer modified adhesive, joint filling, cutting, surface preparation, hacking/chiselling wherever required, disposal of debris, necessary carpentry work and complete finishing as per approved specifications.

9. Wooden Door

Providing and fixing teak wood doors complete with teak wood frame, solid teak shutter (35–38 mm thick), including all necessary hardware such as hinges, tower bolts, aldrops, handles, screws and accessories complete in all respects.

10. Sliding Acoustic Door

Providing and fixing one sliding acoustic teak wood door complete with heavy-duty sliding track, rollers, floor guides, locking arrangement, soft-close mechanism, acoustic seals, automatic drop-down bottom seal, handles and all accessories. Approved hardware brands shall include **Hafele, Hettich, ASSA ABLOY, GEZE** or equivalent.

11. Electrical Conduiting Works

Providing complete concealed electrical conduit system for the Audio Video Room including conduits for power supply, UPS supply, lighting fixtures, wall-mounted fans, cassette AC units, interactive display panel, PTZ/Owl camera, HDMI, USB, AUX, CAT-6/LAN and other audio-video equipment as per site requirements.

The work shall include:

- Concealed PVC conduit installation with necessary chasing and making good.
- GI modular boxes, junction boxes, bends and accessories.
- Dedicated conduits for HDMI, CAT-6/LAN, UPS, Power and spare AV cabling.
- Installation of specified GI boxes of various sizes.
- Testing, commissioning and ensuring complete readiness for installation of AV equipment.

12. Wall Putty, Primer and Painting

Providing and applying white cement-based wall putty, followed by one coat of water-thinnable cement primer and three or more coats of premium quality acrylic emulsion paint of approved make (**Asian Paints Apcolite Premium/Nerolac/Dulux** or equivalent). The work shall include surface preparation, minor repairs, and protection of adjoining finishes and complete cleaning after completion.

General Scope

- All materials shall be of approved makes and conform to relevant BIS/CPWD specifications.
- The contractor shall provide all labour, tools, tackles, machinery, scaffolding and consumables required for successful completion of the work.
- All dismantled debris shall be removed from the Institute premises and the site shall be handed over in neat and clean condition.
- The contractor shall protect existing services, furniture, fixtures and surrounding structures from damage during execution.
- Any damage caused during the work shall be repaired/borne by the contractor at no extra cost.
- The work shall be executed strictly as per the directions of the Engineer-in-Charge/Administrative Officer and to the complete satisfaction of the Institute.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT:-

1. Work Completion Time

The entire work should be completed within **30 (Thirty) days** from the commencement of the work. Work should be commenced within 7 (seven) days of the issuance of work order. In case of failure of the successful bidder to adhere to the above timeline, compensation for delay of work @ 1% per months of delay, to be computed on per day basis of the ordered value of work, will be recovered by IEG from the successful bidder.

2. Eligibility Criteria

In order to be eligible for bidding, the Tendering firm must possess the following:

- a) A valid PAN card
- b) A valid GST Registration Certificate.
- c) Experience of successfully completed or substantially completed similar works during last seven years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited should be either of the following:
 - 1.1 Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost; or
 - 1.2 Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost; or
 - 1.3 One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.
- d) Certificate of Registration/Incorporation of Companies/Firm.

“Similar Work” means “Civil and Electrical Conduit work in auditorium/Audio Video Room/conference room.

3. Terms of Payment

Payment will be released to the contractor on the **satisfactory actual work done and based on the actual measurement**, however, the Performance Security @ 10% of the value of the contract (to be submitted by way of Demand Draft/Pay Order drawn on any Scheduled Commercial Bank in favour of Institute of Economic Growth, Delhi) will be kept to cover the defects liability for a period of one year from the date of completion. During this period, if any defect is found, the same shall be got rectified immediately by contractor at no extra cost to IEG. No advance payment will be made to the contractor under any circumstances.

4. Tender Fee & EMD

The Tender Fee amount of ₹500/- (Rupee five hundred only) and Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) amount **Rs. 13,750/-** (Rupees Thirteen Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Only) has to be submitted by way of Demand Draft/Pay Order drawn on any Scheduled Commercial Bank in favour of Institute of Economic Growth, Delhi. Payment by any other mode will not be accepted. However, the Bidders registered with MSME/NSIC will be granted exemption from payment of Tender Fee & EMD as per Rule. The EMD of all the unsuccessful bidders will be returned after the award of the contract/work order to the successful bidder, however the EMD of successful bidder will only be returned on receipt of Performance Security/

Security Deposit. EMD of the tendering firms who submit the Tender but withdraw the same before expiry of the Tender validity date may be forfeited at the discretion of IEG.

4. Security Deposit

Performance Security @ 10% of the value of the contract will have to be submitted by the successful bidder at the time of acceptance of offer letter by way of Demand Draft/Pay Order drawn on any Scheduled Commercial Bank in favour of Institute of Economic Growth, Delhi. On receipt of Performance Security/Security Deposit, the EMD will be returned to the successful bidder. The Performance Security will be kept as security to cover the defects liability for a period of one year from the date of completion. During this period, in case any defect is detected in the executed job then the same shall be got rectified immediately by the contractor at no extra payment. The security deposit so submitted shall bear no interest. The Security Deposit will be forfeited if the contractor fails to execute the work partially or fully according to the terms and conditions of LOI/ Work Order for any reason whatsoever.

5. Rates

Rates should be quoted on item rate in the enclosed Performa as per **Annexure-B** attached with the Tender document. All rates should be inclusive of all applicable taxes. Rates will remain fixed during the currency of the contract, even if there is a variation in the Cost Index.

6. Employment Obligation

There will be no Employer-Employee relationship whatsoever between IEG and the workers to be deployed by the contractor under the contract and no claim for any employment will be entertained or tenable. The contractor shall render the services to IEG as an independent contractor and it shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor to regulate their terms of employment with the engaged persons without any liability whatsoever on IEG. The contractor shall comply with all the relevant Acts, Rules, Laws and other statutory provisions, regulations, by-laws etc. in connection with execution of the work which are currently in force or to be enforced/revised by the Government from time to time.

7. Award of Contract

IEG will award the contract to the bidder whose Bid has been determined to be substantially responsive and who has offered the lowest evaluated tender price.

Notwithstanding the above, IEG reserves the right to seek previous Work Orders, references etc. and to accept or reject any quotations and to cancel the process and reject all tenders at any time prior to award of contract.

The bidder whose rate is accepted will be notified for the award of contract by IEG prior to expiry of the Tender validity period. The terms and conditions stipulated in the Tender document shall be fully applicable to the resultant contract and taken as an integral part of the contract concluded on the basis of this Tender Enquiry.

Contract will be awarded to the firm offering the lowest/Net Bundled price and not with the reference to the lowest prices quoted for the sub-items. The issuance of Work Order will depend upon the requirement of the IEG and on actual basis.

8. Discipline

The contractor shall maintain strict discipline among their workforce and shall review their performance at regular intervals, personnel employed by the contractor, who are found to be indisciplined or whose performance is not satisfactory, as noticed by the contractor or as reported by the authorized officer of IEG, shall be replaced by the contractor immediately without causing any disruption in the assigned work. The contractor shall be solely and fully responsible and liable for the act, conduct and behavior of their personnel. In case of any misconduct and/ or criminal activities by any of their personnel. The matter will be brought

to the notice of the contractor by IEG for necessary action. The contractor shall remain liable for any damage caused to the property or person of IEG by any person engaged by him. In addition, IEG reserves the right to initiate legal proceedings against such person or persons and/or the contractor for recovery of damages so caused.

9. Penalty

In the event the contractor fails to comply with any of the clauses of the contract or any other statutory requirement that is binding upon him, IEG shall deduct an amount equal to 10% from the running bill.

In case of financial loss/liability incurred due to negligence/default on the part of the contractor or his staff, non-compliance of the provisions of the applicable Acts/ Statutes/ Legislation/ Rules or regulations relevant to the contract, IEG reserves the right to recover such monetary losses from the running bill/ security deposit of the contractor.

The contractor shall maintain a high quality of work under the scope of the contract. If any defect in quality is noticed, then the same shall be got rectified by him within 48 hours at his own cost.

The successful bidder has to start the work within 7 days of issuance of Work Order and **complete the work within 30 days thereafter, failing which IEG will recover Compensation for Delay of work @ 1% per month of delay to be computed on per day basis of the contract value.**

10. Statutory Deductions

All the statutory deductions towards GST / Income Tax/ Electricity/Water etc. shall be made from the bill/s as applicable as per the prevailing rates under the rules. TDS as applicable will be deducted from each bill of the contractor under the statutory rules of the Union Govt., in respect of Income Tax and other taxes. No claim on account of any other statutory charges for execution of work awarded under this contract will be entertained by IEG and such charges should be paid by the contractor himself.

11. Indemnification

IEG shall have no liability whatsoever towards the persons deployed by the contractor for the subject of work. The contractor shall keep IEG indemnified against all losses/ damages/ liabilities/ claims arising out of deployment of the contractor's workers during the period of the contract. Any claim which may arise during the currency of the contract or at any subsequent point of time, shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor and IEG shall in no way be held responsible for it.

12. Liability against loss or Damage to life or Property

The contractor shall be liable to pay IEG for any loss/damage caused as a result of theft/pilferage of any property of IEG from the premises where the staffs of the contractor have been deployed, provided such loss/ damage is due to the negligence of the contractor or its deployed manpower.

The contractor shall also be liable for the consequences of any incident of major/minor injury or death caused to any of its worker arising out of or in the course of his employment under the scope of the contract.

IEG shall not be responsible for any injury or loss of life in respect of the contractor that may take place while on work. Any compensation or expenditure towards treatment for such injury or loss of life shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor. The contractor shall be solely responsible for any damage, injury or accident that may occur to any of his personnel working under his contract. No claim whatsoever arises to IEG.

13. Liquidated Damages

If the contractor fails to execute the contract either in full or in part or fails to observe the terms and conditions set hereinabove or herein below, the entire loss/damage sustained by IEG shall be reimbursed by the contractor and/or will be recovered from the contractor's running bills. In case of financial loss/liability incurred due to the negligence/default of the contractor, the same will be recovered from the contractor's running bills.

14. Termination of the Contract in Full or in Part

The contract will be automatically terminated upon the expiry of the period of the contract. The contract may also be terminated by either of the parties after serving a notice of one month to the other party or payment of charges in lieu thereof. Any complaints pending on the day of giving notice and also before the expiry of the notice served shall have to be attended in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract.

IEG may terminate the contract in full or part, subject to the said provision, in case of failure/ neglect/ default/ refusal on the part of the contractor to perform satisfactorily as per the scope of the contract. In such an event, IEG reserves the right to get the balance work executed through alternate source(s) at the risk and cost of the contractor and the security deposit of the contractor shall stand forfeited. Further, in the event of termination, the contractor shall vacate the site/ premises peacefully and remove the personnel deployed by him within the stipulated period as decided by IEG. The decision of IEG competent authority in this regard shall be final and binding upon the contractor.

In case of breach of any of the terms & conditions of the agreement, the Institute shall be at liberty to terminate the contract forthwith without prejudice to the right of the Institute to claim damages on account thereof and the Contractor and his personnel shall vacate the area of operation for this purpose on the expiry of such period. In the event of such termination of the contract, the refund of Performance Security/Security Deposit would be subject to deduction of any dues, penalties or other recoveries etc.

15. Foreclosure of Contract in Full or in Part

If at any time after issuance of work order, IEG decides to foreclose or reduce the scope of the work and hence not require the whole or any part of the work to be carried out by the contractor, IEG shall give 10 days' notice in writing to that effect to the contractor. In case any such action is taken by IEG, the contractor shall be paid full amount for the quantum of work executed till the date of foreclosure. No compensation, however, shall be paid by IEG for the period of work not executed.

16. Force Majeure

If at any time during the continuance of this contract, the performance in whole or part is prevented or delayed by reason of war, an act of terrorism, act of hostility by public enemy, civil disruption or sabotage, fire, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lock-outs or natural calamities like flood, earthquake or severely inclement weather, provided notice of the happening of any such eventuality is given by either party to the other within 2 days from the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall by reasons of such event be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance/ execution under the contract.

Provided also that such performance/ execution under the contract should commence as soon as practicable, after such event comes to an end or ceases to exist, and the decision of IEG as to whether the performance has been so resumed or not shall be final and conclusive. Provided further that if the performance in whole or in part of the execution under this contract is prevented or delayed by reasons of any such event for a period exceeding 60 days, either party may opt to terminate the contract.

17. Subletting/ Subcontracting

Subletting or subcontracting of the contract, either in full or part, is not allowed under any circumstance. In other words, the contractor shall not enter into any sub-contract with any person or transfer the contract or any benefit thereunder to any person or firm without written permission and approval of IEG.

18. Resolution of Disputes

- (a) Save where expressly stated to the contrary in this contract, any dispute, difference or controversy of whatsoever nature between the parties, however arising under, out of or in relation to this contract including disputes, if any, with regard to any act, decision or opinion of any of the party and so notified in writing by either party to the other, the "Dispute" shall in the first instance be attempted to be resolved amicably in accordance with the procedure set forth in para (b) below.
- (b) Either party may require such Dispute to be referred to the concerned officials of IEG and the contractor for amicable settlement. Upon such reference, the two shall meet at the earliest opportunity as per their mutual convenience and in any event within fifteen (15) days of such reference to discuss and attempt to amicably resolve the dispute by mutual consultation. If the dispute is not amicably settled within fifteen (15) days of such meeting, either party may refer the dispute to arbitration in accordance with the provisions of arbitration clause. In such an eventuality, the party intending to start arbitration shall have to give notice to the other party of its intention to commence arbitration shall have to give notice to the other party of its intention to commence arbitration as per the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act.

19. Arbitration

1. In the event of any question, dispute/ difference arising under the agreement or in connection herewith (except as to matters the decision of which is specially provided under this contract) the same shall be referred to the sole Arbitration of the Director, IEG or his nominee.
2. The decision of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties. In the event of such Arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred is unable to act for any reason whatsoever, the Director, IEG shall appoint another person to act as the Arbitrator in place of the original Arbitrator in accordance with the terms of this agreement. The Arbitrator so appointed shall be entitled to proceed with the reference from the stage which was left by his predecessor or afresh as the case may be. The Arbitrator may give interim award and/or directions, as may be required.
3. Subject to the aforesaid provisions, the Arbitration & Conciliation Act and the rules made thereunder and any modification thereof from time to time being in force, shall be deemed to apply to the Arbitration proceedings under this clause.

20. Miscellaneous

- (i) The workers to be deployed by the contractor should be physically fit and not be suffering from any chronic disease/ ailment. They should be of sound physical and mental health and should be free from any physical disability which would interfere in the normal discharge of their duties.
- (ii) The contractor shall deploy adequate manpower as per actual requirements. It will be the responsibility of the contractor to supervise the work of the personnel deployed by him and ensure fast and speedy disposal of work without compromising on the quality of the work.

- (iii) The contractor shall be fully responsible for the safe custody of the materials/ equipment/ documents relevant to the contract till handing over the materials/ documents to the authorized officer of IEG.
- (iv) 100% material to be submitted before start of work and same has to be vetted through manufacturer.
- (v) The contractor is responsible for any accident during duty hours at work site. All medical treatment/ medical expenditure incurred for the treatment of the injured worker shall be borne by the contractor.
- (vi) IEG reserves the right to award parallel contract or award part of the work to other agency(s) in the event of failure of the contractor to perform the functions as per the Work Order to the satisfaction of IEG and the same will be at the risk and cost of the contractor.
- (vii) The works shall be strictly carried out as per the latest CPWD specification of work and works manual under the supervision of Administrative Officer.
- (viii) After finishing of work, Debris (Malba), if any, shall be removed by the bidder at his own cost.
